

Paper Eggs

Read Romans 5: 1-2

Do You'll need: white and red card, split pins, hole punch, scissors, small lolly or chocolate.

1. Cut the card into strips of 15cm x 2cm - 5 red and 5 white.
2. Place all the strips on top of each other, alternating the colours - one red, one white etc.
3. Punch a hole at each end of the strips. Place a split pin through one end. Fan all the strips out. Bring them all together to form a ball and put another pin in the other end.
4. Take some paper and wrap it around the lolly or chocolate and write an Easter blessing on the outside. Place it inside the egg.
5. Give the egg away to a friend or neighbour.

Talk The red card represents the blood of Jesus and the white card the cloths wrapped around him. He came to give us new life, which is represented by the 'egg'. Inside the 'egg' is the sweet victory of His gift to us; the gift of eternal life. This is what we celebrate at Easter and the reason we give each other chocolate eggs.
